

Tuition Policy

IN FAIRNESS TO ALL STUDENTS, THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THE FOLLOWING TUITION POLICY.

- 1. Monthly tuition is due the 1st of each month and is late after the 15th.**
- 2. A \$5.00 late charge will be automatically added to your tuition if payment has not been received by the 15th of the month.**
- 3. Tuition is required each month, regardless of attendance, unless a student drops the class and informs the office. Tuition reserves your place in class. The registration fee must be paid again if there is a need to re-enroll.**
- 4. Tuition paid for one month may not be carried over as credit into future months even if classes are missed and not made up. The studio is closed for the following Holidays: Labor Day, Halloween, Thanksgiving, Winter Break, Spring Break and Memorial Weekend. Monthly tuition remains the same. Students are offered make-up classes for those classes missed.**
- 5. Make-up classes are at the student's responsibility and must be taken within 30 days of a student's return to class. Make-up classes are for registered students only and are not transferable. Make-up classes may only be taken in classes that the student is not already enrolled in.**
- 6. Leave your check at the front desk and if paying with cash, be sure to get a receipt.**
- 7. Returned checks are subject to a \$25.00 Bank Service Charge.**

Tuition Rates

A non-refundable yearly Registration Fee is required for all classes. Family rate is for siblings only, not extended family.

Unlimited Tuition Rate-per student **\$150 per month**

Unlimited classes are available for students in Ballet IIb & higher. In order to receive this rate, students must be attending regular Ballet classes in addition to other styles. Tuition for Unlimited Students remains the same for all months.

Dress Code

Dancers must come appropriately dressed for class, otherwise they will not be permitted to participate. No necklaces, bracelets or dangling earrings are allowed. Label all clothing and shoes. Hair accessories must be kept to a minimum, as they can become very distracting, especially to younger students.

Creative & Pre Ballet with Jazz/Tap- Danceworks embroidered pink leotard, Capezio pink tights, and pink leather ballet slippers with elastic sewn across the top to hold shoe securely on the foot. Students enrolled in Creative II with Tap or Pre Ballet with Jazz/Tap must also have black flat tap shoes with buckle closure. Hair must be pulled back into a secure bun. No skirts during class.

Ballet- Danceworks embroidered leotard. Specific color according to class level. All dancers must wear Capezio pink tights and pink ballet slippers. Hair must be pulled back into a secure bun.

Hip Hop & Jazz- Black Danceworks tank top or Danceworks embroidered leotard, black jazz pants, and black jazz shoes. Black Revolution dance sneakers are recommended for Hip Hop. Hair must be pulled into a secure ponytail.

Tap- Black Danceworks tank top or Danceworks embroidered leotard, black jazz pants, and black tap shoes. Hair must be pulled into a secure ponytail.

Contemporary & Lyrical- Danceworks embroidered black leotard, beige stirrup tights, black dance shorts, and tan lyrical sandals. Hair must be pulled into a secure ponytail.

Flamenco- Any style/color leotard, Flamenco skirt, and black Flamenco shoes. Castanets will also be needed. Hair must be pulled into a secure bun.

BellyDance- Black camisole top or sports bra, black jazz pants or leggings, and any color coin hip skirt. Students dance in their bare feet.

Salsa- Danceworks embroidered black leotard, black skirt, and Capezio tan tights. Shoes differ according to level. Please consult the studio for further information. Hair must be pulled into a secure ponytail.
